

The Parent Pledge

Cooperation among coaches, parents and personnel is essential if students are to realize the value of athletic participation. Like coaches and athletes, parents must make commitments to the program to assure such cooperation. We ask that you read the following pledge and as needed discuss your reactions with your child's coach or the Director of the gym. **Thank you for your help.**

As a parent of an athlete in this gym, I promise:

- To work closely with all personnel to assure a positive experience for my child.
- To leave all coaching duties up to the staff and personnel that runs the gym.
- To assure that my child will attend all scheduled practices and athletic contest. (when applicable).
- To accompany my child to as many orientations and informational meetings offered by the gym as my schedule permits.
- To require my child to abide by the gym's training rules.
- To acknowledge the ultimate authority lies with their coach in determining training and level selection.
- To promote mature behavior from students and parents during practices and meets.
- To work cooperatively with other parents and show respect to RRVGC personnel to assure a whole-some and successful program.
- To work closely with coaches and other personnel to identify a reasonable and realistic language or behavior while a member of RRVGC.
- To take full responsibility to meet all deadlines including financial, competitive, or other gym scheduled programs.

If any violation of said pledge is shown, the consequences will be in effect for all violators. The penalties are:

1. First time offense will result in a written reprimand and meeting with the Director.
2. Second offense is a 3 month suspension for the parent (Not allowed in the gym for any circumstance).
3. Third offense results in dismissal of student and parent for one calendar year. Re-enrollment will be determined only after having a meeting with the Director.
